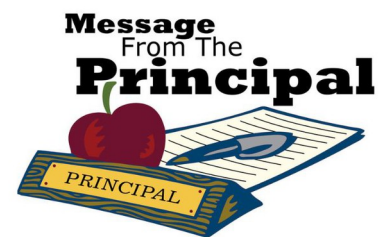


RUDOLPH FAMILY NEWSLETTER

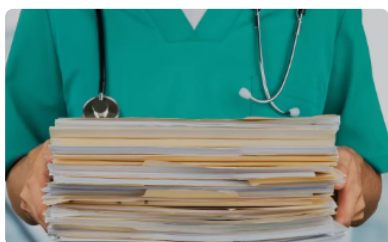

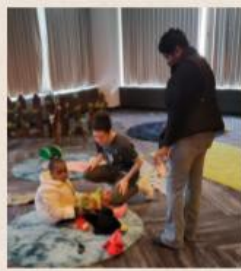
